### HOMEWORK

## MATHS

We will continue to follow the White Rose Maths Mastery scheme of work in class 4. Year 6 start the year learning about Algebra and then we move onto Fractions, Decimals and Percentages, Area and finish with Statistics. Year 5 will start with Multiplication and Division then continues with the same topics as Year 6. In all learning, we will continue to develop fluency and reasoning skills.

## LITERACY

Our book this half-term is 'Curiosity – The Story of A Mars Rover.' We will use the story to write across many genres including poetry, descriptive writing, explanation texts and narrative writing; There will be lots of opportunity for guided reading opportunities and the children will continue to develop their inference and deduction skills.' On Thursday afternoons, we will concentrate on grammar, spelling and punctuation skills and much of this learning will be reinforced through specific homework activities.

### SCIENCE and RE

Our Science topic this half term is 'Electricity' The children will learn about circuits, symbols, insulators and conductors. In RE we will be looking at Justice and Freedom and reading a range of stories from different world religions examining this topic.

## GEOGRAPHY and ART

In Geography we will be looking at 'The Amazing Americas'. The children will find out about the continents of North and South America and the countries that form them. In Art, we will be looking at South and Central American art
