



Welcome back everyone.

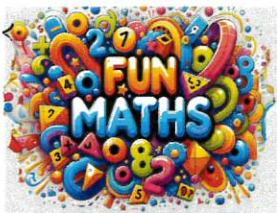
We hope you had a restful summer break.

We have lots of fun and exciting things planned for this term, our theme is:

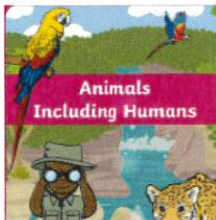
'BEING ME!'

They have paired reading everyday as part of Phonic lessons and they read individually to Mr Kelsey our reading volunteer once each week.

Children will bring their reading book home every day, please read with them every evening. They need to read the book three times before we change it. This helps them to develop fluency and confidence.

They can also choose library books to bring home to share with you; this will encourage the children to read for enjoyment and create a love of reading.
