MATHS

Children will be spending this half-term revising and expanding on key skills, such as addition, multiplication and place value. This term we will be looking at multiple factors and mental strategies, and multiplication. We will also be developing mathematical fluency and reasoning skills to broaden pupils depth, knowledge and mastery in Maths.

SCIENCE and RE

We will be exploring 'Scientist and Inventors.' This will involve looking at famous scientist throughout history. In RE we will be looking at stories of creation, starting with the Hindu perspective then looking at stories in other faiths.

LITERACY



Our topic this half-term is 'Scientist and Inventors.' We will be writing biographies; focusing on developing our knowledge of features of this text type and then creating our own biographies. There will be lots of guided reading opportunities in class where children will develop their inference and deduction skills, as well as exploring poetry in the form of 'The Undefeated.' They will then build on these key skills to develop their own narrative writing based on this theme. Children will also be revising, and updating, their SPAG knowledge.

GEOGRAPHY and ART

In Geography we will be looking at 'Magnificent Mountains.' This will provide an opportunity to find out more about mountains in the UK and abroad. In Art we will be looking at the work of different artists who've created work based on flower and fauna, including Georgia O'Keefe and Henri Rousseau.
