HOMEWORK

Homework will continue to be handed out on Friday, with a hand in date of Wednesday. This will consist of one piece of maths, one piece of English and reading. The maths the children will be given will be a repeat or recap of work they have done in class and closely follows the scheme of work we use in school. The English will either be a piece of spelling, punctuation and grammar work, or a piece of reading comprehension.Reading is expected to be done at least once over the weekend.

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SNACKS AND DRINKS



Children can bring a snack for break time, please make sure it is a healthy one. Please remember that we are a nut free school. Children will also need a named water bottle to keep in class. We please ask that only water is in the drinks bottle. However, you are more than welcome to add a slice of fruit to give it flavor.

MATHS

This term, Year 3 will be looking at place value in numbers up to 1,000. They will also be learning to formally solve addition and subtraction questions, before moving on to timestable work as part of their unit on multiplication and division. Year 4 will also be looking at place value in numbers up to 10,000 before looking at four operations and a unit on calculating area.

SCIENCE

This term we will be looking at 'Rocks' in science. We will be looking at different types of rocks and how they are formed. The children will be learning to sort, classify and organize rocks through the unit.

HISTORY and ART

In History, the children will be learning about The Stone Age and how Britain transitioned into the Iron Age. The children will be learning how humans survived in the Stone Age and how tools changed. In art, we will be looking at Autumn and how it is depicted in artworks.

LITERACY

Our book for this half term is 'Ug', a Stone Age story linked to our History unit. The children will be learning about character description, postcards and game instructions. The children will have a weekly reading comprehension lesson where we will focus on retrieval skills and beginning to answer some inference and deduction questions.
