HOMEWORK

MATHS

This term, Year 3 will be continuing fractions, looking at find fractions of amounts in both unit and non-unit format. They will also be looking at money, statistics, time and shape. Year 4 will continue looking at decimals, sorting them and looking at them in different contexts. They will also be completing units on money, time, shape, statistics and position.

LITERACY



Our book for this half term is 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. They children will be reading the story and learning how to structure a story through drafting and using paragraphs. The children will be using these skills to write recounts, persuasive letters, list poetry, questions from the text, newspaper reports and annotate illustrations from the text.

SCIENCE and RE

We will be exploring 'States of Matter'. We will be looking at how matter comes in solids, liquids and gases. We will be looking at the water cycle and how the temperature contributes to this. In RE we will be looking at famous people and how their faith has impacted their lives

GEOGRAPHY and ART

In Geography we will be looking at 'Extreme Earth'. In this unit, we will cover the extremes of life on Earth and how the planet functions. We will be looking at tectonic plates, earthquakes, volcanos, tornados, tsunamis and the different layers of the Earth's crust.
