HOMEWORK

The English will either be a piece of spelling, punctuation and grammar work, or a piece of reading comprehension. Reading is expected to be done at least once over the weekend.

MATHS

This term, Year 3 will be learning about length and perimeter. They will also be using the knowledge they have acquired in our unit on multiplication and division to learn about fractions. The year 3s will also be learning about mass and capacity. The year 4s will be completing their unit on multiplication and division, they will then also be moving onto length and perimeter, then fractions before completing the final unit on decimals.



LITERACY

Our book for this half term is 'The King of the Sky', a big book that looks at belonging and acceptance. The children will be writing setting descriptions, balanced arguments and newspaper reports. The children will continue having their weekly reading comprehension lessons on a Friday.

SCIENCE

This term we will be looking at 'Plants' in science. We will be looking at different types parts of plants and their functions. The children will be learning how plants reproduce and conduct investigations involving plants.

Geography and ART

In Geography, the children will be learning about the geography of the United Kingdom. In this unit, children will be learning about the location of major British cities, looking at the UK's climate and looking at various British rivers and seas. In art, the children will be looking at European art and artists, looking at important work by famous European artists.
